We hope you are in the best of health and Iman. We would like to thank you for your cooperation and support through these difficult times and as it seems, we may require further patience and resolve to be successful in the months approaching. May Allah (swt) protect us all and enable us to continue together in this journey of sacred knowledge.

Delay for January 2021 Return

We are writing to inform all parents and guardians, in light of the latest government announcement, that the return for Jamia students will be delayed until **Sunday 17th of January** for residential students and **Monday 18th January** for day students. This is most unfortunate as we were looking forward to welcoming everyone back this coming Sunday. We contacted the DfE to seek clarification and to see if any exemption could be made but they made it very clear that, whatever measures we put in place, the Government announcement applies to all independent schools/Darul Ulooms.

We expect all students to have a Covid test before returning on **Sunday 17th/Monday 18th January** in line with our risk assessment to protect everyone returning. Once students are back in Jamia, we will be using rapid test kits for asymptomatic students (who have been in close contact with someone with Covid symptoms) which will In Shaa Allah reduce further disruption.

We expect GCSE students in particular to upload their work on the Google classroom as set by the teachers and they will find more work on there for them to complete. All students should be revising in preparation for the exams after their return.
